



minha terra Network is a public interest private non-profit organization that brings together 58 Local Development Associations in Portugal – mainland and the autonomous regions, Azores and Madeira.

These organisations carry out a qualified and integrated intervention in rural areas, developing and implementing local development strategies through social, economic, cultural, environmental and educational projects and initiatives, making use of different tools, taking into consideration that LEADER and Community-Led Local Development play an important role.

Thanks to its experience, competence, knowledge and representativeness *minha terra* Network is present in several advisory structures at a regional, national and international level, with a special emphasis on the Economic and Social Council, a constitutional body for consultation and social concertation, where Minha Terra represents Family Farming and Rural Communities Organisations.



At the international level, minha terra Network is Member of ELARD — European LEADER
Association for Rural Development that is committed to the construction of a European rural policy and that brings together more than 2500 bodies from 26 countries, including from countries that are not members of the European Union but have adopted and are implementing the LEADER methodology.

minha terra Network assumed the presidency of ELARD for 2018-2019.






**LEADER** was created by the European Commission in 1991 with the purpose to respond to a crisis of the development in rural areas of the European Union. It played an essential role in the constitution of local partnerships and technical teams qualified in rural areas, both driven by the wish for a new development culture.

## The intervention of the LAGs is based on a set of **seven key principles** that define **LEADER**:

- Community-led local development strategies
- Participatory design and implementation (bottom-up) of the strategies
- Local public-private partnerships: Local Action Groups
- Integrated multi-sectoral approach
- Innovation
- Cooperation
- Networking
